## Pictorial guide of overarching themes and factors related to carer mental health


The Seven, numbered, overarching themes were identified from analysis of the qualitative\* evidence.

Each piece of quantitative\* evidence found was categorised into one of the overarching themes. The arrows represent this quantitative evidence.

Arrows in green represents evidence of a positive relationship between parts of that theme and carer mental health.

Arrows in red represents evidence of a negative relationship.

Size of arrow suggests amount of quantitative evidence.













<sup>\*</sup>Qualitative evidence is usually words or pictures that describe people's own stories and experiences. Quantitative evidence is usually numbers or statistics which measure something (e.g., level of pain or anxiety) or captures observable information (e.g., length of time caring).
