## **Executive Summary**

Gobby was chosen as a method to engage with the PCIE to help shape the future of the PCIE forum and measure its' impact. The PCIE forum are looking to co-produce feedback and support suggestions on the future of the forum.

The questionnaire was presented at a PCIE Forum meeting on the 12<sup>th</sup> December 2023 and subsequently emailed to the forum members on 18<sup>th</sup> December, the survey was closed on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2024.

All questions asked allowed for free-text responses that could be viewed (by search) by other survey respondents and voted for. Alternatively, they could add their own unique response.

Three main themes emerged from the responses offered:

- 1. Networking
- 2. Equity, Diversity & Inclusion
- 3. Research and Learning

Themes demonstrate that the PCIE Forum is of real value to those that attend. There's scope to develop the Forum further in terms of purpose (impact), developing meaningful connections, and impact measurement.


